

REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL, LINCOLN, ALABAMA

July 26, 2022

The City Council of the City of Lincoln, Alabama met in regular session in the Council Chambers at City Hall on Tuesday, July 26, 2022 at 6:00 p.m. Mayor Watson called the meeting to order and upon roll call the following answered present: Mayor Watson, Councilmembers Sadie Britt, Billy Pearson, Jennie Jones, Brandon Tate and Joey Callahan. Invocation was given by Billy Pearson and Mayor Watson led the Pledge of Allegiance. Councilmember Britt recorded the minutes in the clerk's absence.

Mayor Watson opened the Public Hearing regarding the nuisance abatement at 180 Albert Drive. Mr. Timothy Colley requested that he be granted permission to continue the work being done on his house. Councilmember Tate asked for a time line on how long it would take to complete and Councilmember Callahan asked if he would be willing to hire an engineer to assess what should be done. Mr. Colley stated he should be finished in a year and he did not commit to hiring an engineer. Adam Thrasher explained how notices have been sent and what is needed to comply with state and local ordinances. William Bishop, Mr. Colley's neighbor, was in attendance to support him and his work. No decision was made on the issue and Mayor Watson closed the Public Hearing.

Councilmember Britt made a motion to approve the minutes of July 12, 2022; second by Pearson. The vote was Pearson – Aye, Britt – Aye, Jones – Aye, Tate – Aye and Callahan – Aye.

Mayor Watson presented Resolution 2022 – 40 authorizing the City to join the State of Alabama and other local governments as participants in current and future opioid settlements. Councilmember Tate made a motion to adopt Resolution 2022-40; second by Callahan. The vote was Pearson – Aye, Britt – Aye, Jones – Aye, Tate – Aye and Callahan – Aye.

There being no further business to come before the Council, Pearson made a motion to adjourn; second by Callahan. The vote was Ayes: Britt, Pearson, Jones, Tate and Callahan.
